

## PTA General Membership Meeting January 20, 2021, 9:30am Via Zoom Meeting Minutes

- I. 9:34am meeting called to order by Maya & Stella, co-Presidents.
  - a. Reminder of zoom protocols please leave questions in the chat.
- II. 9:35am Marcia, co-secretary, reading and approval of the minutes. Motion to waive reading, second, and approved.
- III. 9:36am Treasures' report, Mike gives an update.
  - a. Revenue: 58% of our budget.
    - i. Received revenue for direct appeal, auction, and school supplies. Some rolled over to January. We'll continue with Direct Appeal to the end of the year.
  - b. Expenditures: Expect the number to go up in the spring with planning for next year, graduation, and javas.
- IV. 9:38am Principal's report, Jacqui.
  - Big day today Inauguration Day. Classes 1 4 are synchronous, 5 7 asynchronous.
    School discussed what to do about the inauguration. Decided it was a personal choice to watch with families, to see our democracy at work, and not to take it for granted.
    Teachers are prepared for conversations to continue past today.
  - b. When is school reopening? We don't know! Waiting for DOE. Looking forward to having kids back in the building.
  - c. Morton has scheduled informal chats with elementary school families on Monday/Tuesday before Christmas. Two more scheduled on Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Thanks to Maya and the staff for the video.
  - High School meeting on January 28<sup>th</sup> at 9:30am. Guidance counselors have sent 15 16
    High School letters to families. DOE High School admissions is not open yet, but soon.
  - e. January 27<sup>th</sup> is the SHSAT testing day. Welcome back Jill! Ilene is on a SHSAT zoom call with Val. Fish did it yesterday to learn about the process and give to the students.
  - f. Feb. 5<sup>th</sup> is the last day that our two guidance counselors will be able to review HS applications. Applications are due on Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup>. Counselors will give advice, but won't tell families what to do.
  - g. For next year's budget we need to know what families are coming back. Planning of the budget has been based on population. They need to think about September.
  - h. D2 superintendent will be announced shortly.
  - i. Javas with Jacqui and Jill welcomed two doctors last Friday who talked about strategies on what you can do at home to keep the peace, stay calm, and listen in smarter ways to your children, but anyone in the house.
  - j. Interim superintendent came to visit the school last week. Visited 7<sup>th</sup> grade science & math, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade social studies. She left knowing 75 Morton. Picked up on the care and warmth of the school and was amazed by our technology and the communication with and among the students.
