  - a. PTA to vote on 2021-2022 Budget. Expecting to have all events in person next year.
  - b. Expecting to raise 210K in total revenue for next year.
  - c. Direct appeal the number of 87K is similar to the amount for this year. We expect to raise more money but we have fewer students attending.
  - d. Expenditure of \$210K for a balanced budget.
    - i. The amount for academic support will be lower than it has been.
    - ii. Classroom supplies have been purchased this year using DOE funds so we won't need to purchase much next year.
    - iii. Enrichment programs workshops with Ken & Renee will continue. Hopefully you've participated. Highly recommended for teachers and parents.
    - iv. Expenses for in-person graduation will be offset with numbers raised for 8<sup>th</sup> grade package.
    - v. School fundraisers, like the auction expenses will be higher than last year since we'll be in person.
