# VIII. Treasurer's Report

- We raised \$2395 through direct appeal, and \$393 from the school store
- We are in a good financial position as opposed to other schools in district
- We need to focus on fundraising to keep the numbers where they are
- We put money sitting in the bank into a money market account (\$202k) the majority of which is a grant which will be used on technology
- 9 of 9 people in-person voted to spend another \$2500 on merchandise for the school store (this is in addition to the \$2500 which was approved last meeting)
